This recognition comes based on the existing mature evaluation methodology, as well as the practical experience with R155 and R156 applied already with a few OEMs. The other countries members of the 1958 Agreement will directly recognize successful certificates issued in line with this scheme. Besides E49 designation, Bureau Veritas' Secura is currently in the process of designation with other National Approval Authorities.

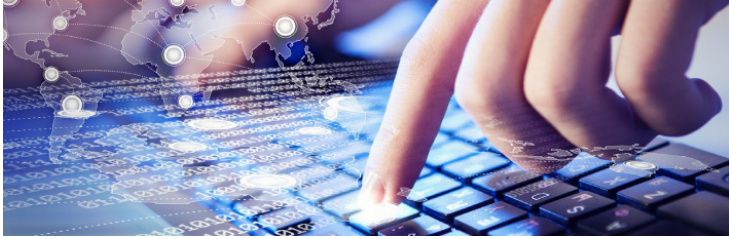
